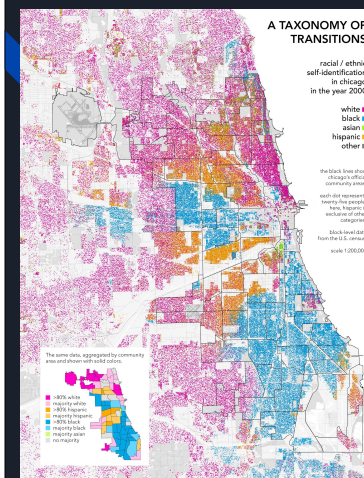


## What happened to them?
